#### PRINCE THOMAS OF SAVOY SCHOLARSHIP

The Prince Thomas of Savoy Society has established a yearly scholarship to be awarded to a member's child, grandchild, or great grandchild who needs financial assistance to pursue a course of study beyond the high school level. The same criteria apply to adopted or stepchildren. Both male and female students are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

### Criteria by Which the Scholarship Is Awarded

A committee composed of members of the Prince Thomas of Savoy Society will review all applications. Only members of the committee that are not related to any of the applicants will be involved in the review process.

In their review, the committee will take into account the financial need, based on estimated cost of education, funds available, and extenuating circumstances such as family income, number of siblings also attending college, loss of job, illness, etc. These factors will be given the highest priority. Other factors that will be given consideration include the applicant's effort to self-finance, academic achievement, record of community service, extra curricular activities and the presentation of the application. If there are more than two qualified applicants a preference may be given to the first time recipient.

The Prince Thomas of Savoy Society guarantees that a minimum of \$3,000 will be available for a scholarship(s) in any given year regardless of the amount of funds in the Scholarship account. It is anticipated that two scholarships of \$1,500 each will be awarded each year.

### Criteria the Applicant Must Meet in Order to Apply for the Scholarship

The applicant must be the child, grandchild, or great grandchild of a Regular or Associate Member of the Prince Thomas of Savoy Society, who has been a member for at least two years.

The applicant must have received a high school diploma or must be scheduled to receive one in the current school year.

The applicant must have been accepted to or be currently enrolled in a college, community college or an institution that offers a technical or other training program for a minimum of two years.

### General Information for the Applicant

The Scholarship recipient will be notified by third Friday in May. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the recipient.

The recipient will be invited, with his/her parents, as guests of the Scholarship Committee, to the Sunday Brunch at which the scholarship will be presented.

The application must be received by April 30th and addressed to:

Incomplete applications or applications submitted after April 30th will not be accepted. The Scholarship Committee has the option to revoke the Scholarship if any information in the application is found to be misleading, false or unfulfilled after the Scholarship has been awarded.

A transcript of all grades from the high school or from the college most recently attended. A copy of transcripts will be sufficient for the initial application process; however, official transcripts may be required upon request.

- 1. Two letters of recommendation from teachers focusing on work ethic and scholarship.
- 2. A single-spaced typewritten essay no more than one page long stating the reasons why you should be considered for the Scholarship. Please keep in mind that this scholarship is based on financial need.
- 3. A brief financial statement, which is part of the application form.

The committee respects and protects the privacy of all information submitted. No information will be shared outside of the committee and copies of all applications will be destroyed once the scholarship is awarded.
