

June 15 Phase 1A

We will now enter into Phase 1A for the reopening of the club. This means there will be some expansion of some of the services and hours of the club while all our current protocols will remain in place.

Hours of the club-

Monday through Friday 5-9pm and Sunday 3-7pm. During these times the club's restrooms will be open.

You will also be allowed to visit the outside property of the club, Monday through Friday 11am-5pm, however the club's restrooms will not be open. People will be able to come down practice bocce, horseshoes or just sitting and relaxing on the grounds. The same protocols will be required during these additional times.

Food and beverages-

Will be available for purchase Monday through Friday 5-9pm and Sunday 3-7pm. Therefore bringing your own beverages to the club will no longer be allowed.

The club will be expanding our cashless system at the club and by July 1 we will have credit card purchases available for food and beverages with a \$10 minimum.

Bocce -

Will be expanded to allow for 4 person teams on each court, this way teams can begin to practice for league start of July 7. All current protocols for Bocce will continue as is. (i.e. Masks, hand

washing and no spectators in the court area.

Since the pavilion is a relatively small area and will be used for hand washing as well as housing our beverage area, the pavilion will be a face mask area.

Requirements for entering the club-

Club Ambassador will be responsible allowing member's entrance

1. Temperature will be taken, if more than 100.4 you will not be allowed in.
2. All members will be signed in.
3. Masks must be worn in proximity of others. The pavilion, bocce courts, and restrooms is a required mask areas.
4. Social distancing needs to be adhered too.
5. Members only, no one under the age of 16.

Requirements for Bocce-

1. Preferences will be given depending on the day, Men (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) Ladies (Monday and Friday) Sunday (no preference)
2. Masks must be worn
3. Number of players has be expended to 8 per court (4 person teams)
4. Only bocce players will be allowed in Bocce area.
5. Players must wash hands before and after matches
6. No Raking of courts by players.

These restrictions and Protocols are for Phase 1A. We will continue to monitor the stage and local changes and make appropriate changes as we move forward toward Phase 2 that is planned to begin July 6th as this impacts parents/ grandparents who may be bringing children under 16 to Monday night Bocce.
